

## Veterans Emergency Temporary Shelter (VETS) Agreement and Liability Waiver

I, \_\_\_\_\_ accept full responsibility for any injuries sustained by me or anyone else while I am in possession of and using a V.E.T.S. temporary shelter. I acknowledge my responsibility for damages occurred to the shelter while in my use. I will indemnify and hold Harmless, V.E.T.S. Inc. and \_\_\_\_\_ for damages incurred by them, including attorney fees, related to my use of the shelter. I understand it is my responsibility to inspect the current condition of the trailer and report any known issues/defects before signing this document. Veterans Emergency Temporary Shelter is designed specifically for homeless Veterans in a crises/emergency, who cannot be placed in motels, homeless shelters or transitional housing. Each unit is carefully inspected prior to relocation ensuring the safety of the occupant, as well as, to guarantee everything functions within the trailer.

By signing this document, you are affirming that you are a homeless Veteran in need of immediate shelter, which is provided at no cost unless you damage this unit. Next, by accepting this trailer, You will try to engage with the homeless Veteran resources available with the goal of being placed into permanent housing. You are under the agreement that as soon as a more permanent housing solution becomes available, whether family, friends, 3<sup>rd</sup> party payment placing you into a motel, Availability at homeless shelters or transitional housing, you will accept the first reasonable option. Finally, you are accepting full responsibility for the permission needed by the property owner to place the trailer in this current location.

You have the only keys for this unit, and no one else will have access during your stay. You will Communicate with us by phone, email, or in person for an update on you status and the status of the unit. You acknowledge the following conditions to access this unit: you engage with homeless Veteran resources, you pursue the availability of a more permanent housing option, and you report Damages or injuries sustained while in use. In addition, if at any time during your stay evidence of Non-Veteran status, your disengagement with homeless Veteran resources/case managers, Knowledge of your personal injury or damages occurred to the unit, the trailer will be reclaimed, Reconditioned, inspected, and assigned to another homeless Veteran. Please respect the owner of this unit by keeping in mind, the condition you leave it will directly result in the time needed to recondition/repair before the next homeless Veteran can be placed.
